

Enter through the yellow swing gates for unloading your gear. For safety issues we can only allow a few cars at a time. You will need to hand in your drivers license, then unload your gear in a spot to the right of the game/activity area. Please no walking, playing or driving on the soccer fields. As you are existing the unloading area, you will get your driver's license back.

You will need to parallel park along the fence and street on Harrison Ave. or along Lagoon Drive and cross over the walking bridge to Scout Island camp area south of the soccer fields.

Be mindful, there will be a noon and an evening adult soccer games going on Saturday. After the soccer players depart around 9-10 PM, you will be allowed to move your car along the side of the gravel road leading to the camping area.
